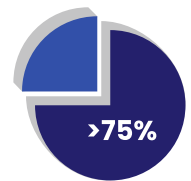
Experts Consensus Report

83% experts* suggest a higher lipid content moisturizer in patients with Atopic Eczema during Winters.

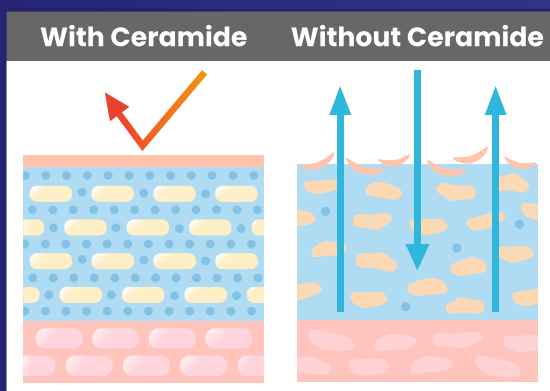
The EuroGuiDerm guideline on AE** was developed in accordance with the EuroGuiDerm Methods Manual v1.3. The guideline development group comprised 26 experts from twelve countries nominated by EuroGuiDerm national partner societies.

We suggest using moisturizers with a hydrophilic formula in the summer and moisturizers with a higher lipid content in the winter in patients with AE.
